

# QRYA COVID-19 Policy

## This document

This policy remains in force as long as the Queensland Government Chief Health Officer describes public health directions that affect travel and or outdoor sport events in Queensland. This policy suspends if Radio Sailing is not possible under changed Queensland Government Directions. The Policy and Plan is to ensure the Organising Authority complies with legal requirements, it is not for the direction of competitors.

## Government Requirements

An Approved Plan for Outdoor Sports has been provided by the Queensland State Government and the Queensland Radio Yachting Association (QRYA) has adopted it for use at all QRYA events. No other approvals are required but compliance to it is. The QRYA will approve events that comply with the Approved COVID-19 Management Plan (The Plan).

## QRYA Requirements

The following is required for each QRYA Supported Event:

1. An Approved COVID-19 Industry Safe Plan (supplied and linked above)
2. The COVID-19 Safe Officer (CSO) must be identified for each event
3. Entrants must be advised of any COVID-19 requirements before the event.
4. The CSO must not be a Race Officer
5. The COVID-19 Plan for the venue must be described at the Race Briefing by the CSO and a copy posted on the Notice Board at the event
6. Entry to and participation in the event is dependant on agreement to comply with the Plan and reasonable directions of the CSO for the duration of the event
7. Racing cannot proceed if an unrectified breach of the Plan exists
8. Breaches of the Plan must be noted and reported to the QRYA

## Actions for Host Clubs to prepare for an Event

1. Appoint the COVID-19 Safe Officer (CSO)
2. Download the Outdoor Sports COVID-19 Plan (linked above)
3. Review Part 1 - Sport Operations (Appendix 1)
4. Establish Attendance Register for Contact Tracing Requirements (Appendix 2)
5. Complete the COVID-SAFE PLAN Checklist (Appendix 3)
6. Note and action any site specific requirements
7. Make several copies of The Plan for use at the event
